The Energy Assistance Program

The Energy Assistance Program helps pay for home heating and furnace repairs for income-qualified households

- The Energy Assistance Program (EAP) is a federally funded program
- Grants are paid directly to your energy provider, or utility company, for your bill.
- Grants range from \$300 - \$2,000
- Grants are available to renters and homeowners.
- Grants are based on energy cost, household size, and income.

Grants may be given to households with income at or below 60 percent of the state media income. Applications for 2021-2022 heating season are now available. Applications must be submitted through:

Caramelized Onion and Cranberry Cheese Toasts



- 2 cups thinly sliced sweet onion such as Vidalia
- 1 Rome Beauty or Jonathan apple, peeled, cored, and coarsely chopped
- ½ cup cranberries
- 2 Tbsp butter, cut up
- ¼ cup balsamic vinegar
- 2 Tbsp packed brown sugar
- ½ tsp finely shredded orange peel
- 8 oz cream cheese, softened
- 32 to 36 baguette-style French bread slices, toasted

In a 1½ quart slow cooker combine onions, apple, and cranberries. Top with butter. In a small bowl combine vinegar, brown sugar, and orange peel; pour over mixture in cooker. Cover and cook on low 5-6 hours or on high 2½ to 3 hours. In a small bowl beat the cream cheese until smooth. To serve, spread cheese mixture on toasted bread slices. Using a slotted spoon, spoon onion mixture on top of cheese.

Protect your lawn mower engine for the winter now. Put a fuel stabilizer in the gas tank and run the engine for a few minutes. Sea foam is one product.

It helps the fuel resist evaporation, preserves ignition vapors, adds protective lubricity, and prevents gum & varnish formation. It will make starting it next spring easier. This can be used in any gas powered equipment you are storing such as a gas trimmer, chain saw, or blower.
