## PLEASE DO NOT PUT GREASE OR WIPES IN THE SEWER

We recently has a sewer back up and the sewer company reports there was a lot of grease and wipes plugging the line. Pouring grease down the drain or flushing baby, makeup, or sanitizing wipes creates these blockages. These service calls are unnecessary and expensive. Grease should be drained into a metal can, cooled, and thrown away. Wipes of all kinds, even the flushable ones, should go in the garbage can.

## Christmas Cracker Toffee

- 32 saltine crackers
- 1 cup unsalted butter  
(2 sticks)
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 2 cups chocolate chips
- 1 cup pecans
- Sprinkles



Preheat oven to 400°. Line a 9x13" baking sheet with foil. Place rows of crackers on the sheet, completely covering it. Set aside. In a medium saucepan, heat the butter and brown sugar over medium heat. Stir continuously and bring to a boil until it reaches 275°. Pour the hot mixture over the saltine crackers. Bake for 4 minutes. Turn off oven. Remove from the oven and sprinkle chocolate chips over top. Put pan back in warm oven for 1 minute to melt the chips. Using a spatula, smooth chocolate chips out. Sprinkle pecans and sprinkles over top. Cool and allow chocolate to harden. Break into pieces.

**Q:** Why is it so important to disconnect my garden hose from the faucet?

**A:** Your garden hose faucet is considered "frost free" because water will automatically drain out so there is nothing to freeze. If a hose is left connected, it creates a vacuum and the water can't drain and will freeze. It will break the faucet and it will need replacing. This involves cutting into the "belly paper" under the home to connect a new faucet. Disconnect your hose, drain and store away for the winter. Also drain out sprinklers and sprayers so they do not freeze and break.
