Mushroom Oven Rice

- 1 cup raw long grain rice
- 1/4 cup butter or margarine
- 1/2 cup finely chopped celery
- 1/2 cup finely chopped onion
- 1 cup sliced fresh mushrooms
- 1 can (14 oz) chicken broth
- 1/3 cup water
- 2 Tbsp. soy sauce
- 1 Tbsp dried parsley (opt)

Sauté rice in butter 2 min. or until golden brown. Add celery and onions and cook 2 minutes more. Add mushrooms and cook until celery is tender. Transfer to 1 1/2 quart casserole, greased. Stir in the broth, water, soy sauce and parsley. Cover and bake at 350 degrees for 45 minutes or until liquid is absorbed and rice is tender. 6 servings

A: Anoka County has a facility that will take these items at no charge. It is located at:
3230 101st Ave. NE in Blaine, not too far from the Anoka County Airport. Their hours are: Weds: 2pm-8pm Sat: 9 am-3 pm.

Items accepted include: Automotive products, home improvement products, household products, lawn and garden products, other household items labeled toxic, corrosive, etc. Items NOT accepted include appliances, batteries, florescent bulbs, and tires. Bring your driver's license, pull into the facility, and the attendant will assist you. No charge.
