The Importance of Homeowner's Insurance

Our recent storm damage reminds us about the importance of having insurance on your home. If your home sustains damage from perils such as fire, hail, or theft, your costs should be covered by your policy.

In addition your policy typically includes protection if someone in your household is found liable for damage to someone else's home OR if a guest is injured at your home. It is important to understand what your policy is covering.

If you have a loan on your home, insurance is required. If you do not have a loan, ***insurance is still required by your Lease.*** If you have been told by your insurance company that they will no longer insure your home because of the age, shop around. If you need the names of some other companies, check with us at the Community office for some ideas.

Mexican Zucchini

Burrito Boats



- 4 large zucchini
 - 1 (15 ounce) can black beans, drained and rinsed
 - 1 cup cooked brown rice
 - 1 cup salsa (use your preferred level of spiciness)
 - 1 red bell pepper, cored and diced
 - 1/2 red onion, diced
 - 1/2 cup corn kernels
 - 1 jalapeno (or poblano pepper), cored and diced
 - 1 tablespoon + 1 teaspoon olive oil
 - 2 teaspoons cumin
 - 1 teaspoon chili powder
 - 1/2 cup fresh cilantro, finely chopped
 - salt to taste
 - 1 cup shredded cheddar/monterey jack cheese
- Grease a 9 x 13" casserole dish and set aside. Slice each zucchini in half lengthwise. Using a melon baller or metal teaspoon, hollow out the center of each zucchini. Lightly brush the tops with one tsp of olive oil then place them skin side down in the casserole dish. Warm 1 Tbsp olive oil in a large skillet over medium heat. Add the onion and the peppers and cook for 2-3 minutes. Then add the rice, corn, and beans along with the salsa, chili powder and cumin. Stir together and continue to cook for about 5 minutes then remove the skillet from the heat and set aside. Preheat the oven to 400°F and stir in 1/4 cup of the cilantro and salt to taste to the filling. Spoon the filling inside of each zucchini until they are all full. Sprinkle each one with cheese, arrange in the dish, and cover with foil. Bake for 25 minutes then remove the foil and set the oven to broil. Broil for 5 minutes, until the cheese is bubbly and golden brown.
