Be a Water Watch Dog

To you see standing water where there shouldn't be? Do you hear the sound of spraying water coming from under your home? Do you hear water running somewhere but are unsure where it's coming from? Please report any water leaks to the Community office as soon as you notice one. We will check it out and try to determine the cause. Water is expensive so we want to get it fixed as soon as possible. If it's a Colonial owned pipe leaking we can take care of it. It has been frustrating in the past when we've had major water leaks and someone has known about it for days and just not gotten around to reporting it. It's also more expensive and a greater inconvenience to our residents to do these repairs late in the day or on a weekend so the sooner we know the better. If it's a homeowner's line, you will want to fix it before more damage can occur. Our office number is 763-786-3498. Zucchini Relish

10 cup zucchini, shredded in
food processor with peel on

8 green peppers

4 red peppers

4 onions, ground

(alternate option: 6 green peppers, 3 red and 3
yellow for color)

Mix together and sprinkle with 5 tbsp salt.

Let stand overnight. The next day squeeze out juice
until quite dry.

Combine: 5 cup sugar

2 ½ cup vinegar

1 tbsp turmeric

1 tbsp celery seed

2 tsp nutmeg

Heat to dissolve sugar. Add vegetables and bring to
a boil. Simmer gently for 30 minutes only. Seal in hot
jars. Good on hamburgers and hot dogs or making
thousand island dressing. Makes about 7 pints.



Q: *How do I clean my vinyl siding?*

A: *Use a sponge with dish soap in a
bucket of water. Use a hard bristled
brush for the tougher spots. Work from
the bottom up and rinse off with your
garden hose. TSP (Tri Sodium
Phosphate) is a stronger cleaning
agent. If you use this instead of dish
soap wear gloves and eye protection.
Pressure washing your vinyl siding is
also effective.*
