## **SPRING CLEANUP DAY with social distancing**

The Colonial Village spring clean up day is **Saturday, May 9th from 8am-1pm.** (Rain or Shine).

Colonial Village provides large dumpsters so that you can do your spring cleaning and dispose of large items **AT NO CHARGE!** (see box for mattress charge) The dumpsters will be located in the parking lot behind the office. Only Colonial Village residents may participate in this clean up. The costs of this service continue to escalate so please only bring items from your household. Note the list of items we can not accept.

To respect social distancing, we will have a one way street to the dumpsters; one vehicle at a time. Please wait until the person leaves before pulling ahead. Please bring enough people to lift your items. Unfortunately we will not have refreshments this year.

### **Metal Curbside Pick Up Friday**

Curbside pick up of some larger metal items is available the day before cleanup on Friday, May 8th. **RESERVATIONS REQUIRED!** You must call the Colonial Village Office to be put on the pick up list. Items include ranges, dishwashers, washers, dryers,

water heaters, BBQ grills, lawn mowers, snowblowers, bikes. These items must be outside by 9:00am the morning of May 8th. Please do not put anything out before then as it would be a health code violation. Other debris must be brought to the dumpsters on Sat. May 9th.

## Quick and Easy Bread Pudding

4 slices buttered bread, cut in squares  
1/2 cup sugar  
3 eggs  
1 tsp vanilla  
1 cup milk  
Cinnamon or nutmeg (optional)

Place bread in bottom of 8" x 8" pan. Beat eggs and sugar; add other ingredients and pour over bread. Sprinkle with cinnamon or nutmeg. Bake at 300° for 40 minutes or until set.

**Q:** *I have been "safe at home" and cleaning. Now I'm ready to get outside. How do I clean my vinyl siding?*

**A:** *Use a sponge with dish soap in a bucket of water. Use a hard bristled brush for the tougher spots. Work from the bottom up and rinse off with your garden hose.*

*TSP (Tri Sodium Phosphate) is a stronger cleaning agent. If you use this instead of dish soap wear gloves and eye protection. Pressure washing your vinyl siding is also effective.*
