Warning: do not put items outside before clean up day. Store items in your home or shed. Can't wait? Walter's in Blaine has a drop off service for a fee. Only Colonial Village residents may participate in this clean up.

APRIL IS SEVERE WEATHER AWARENESS MONTH

The time to plan is now, before an emergency arises. Colonial Village has a storm shelter located at 5700 Squire Lane. When you moved into Colonial you were given a "shelter plan". The plan encourages you to stay alert for public warnings, plan ahead on what you will do, and if the media advises, take shelter.

>Don't be taken by surprise. Be aware of potential severe weather. The National Weather Service and many local media outlets offer electronic alerting services and can provide information on weather, including watches and warnings. Some available services are: National Weather Service, The Weather Channel, Accuweather, WCCO4, KARE11, KSTP5, KMSF/Fox9.

>Allow plenty of time to move to the shelter and bring a phone or a portable radio with you.

>Arrange for those who need assistance. Someone whose mobility is impaired may need help and thought should be given for a plan for them.

>Children home alone need to know what to do in severe weather.

Children should be taught to go home if they hear the sirens while outside.

>Pets brought to the shelter must be adequately restrained. Plan ahead.

The shelter is locked to avoid vandalism but is opened at the first sign of

threatening weather. **Some families in Colonial Village are "key holders" for the shelter. If you would like information on this please call the Community office.**

No Bake Protein Bites

2 cup oats
1 cup Rice Krispies
1 cup peanut butter
2/3 cup honey
2 tsp vanilla
Chocolate chips (optional)
Marshmallows (optional)



In a large bowl, pour in the oats, Rice Krispies, peanut butter, honey, and vanilla extract. Combine everything until all the dry ingredients are well coated. If desired, add a handful of chocolate chips and marshmallows. Stir until these are evenly distributed throughout the mixture. Using a cookie scoop, roll the mixture into bite-sized balls. Place them on a greased pan. Transfer the pan to the refrigerator and let the bites set. This usually takes about an hour. Once set, transfer the protein bites to an airtight container.

Mounds View Compost Site Opens April 1st

The compost site for your leaves and grass is located at Ardan Park: Long Lake Road and Ardan Ave., about a mile west of here. (Take Hillview west to Long Lake Rd. and turn right. The compost site is about 2 blocks north) There is no charge to use the compost site. You drive in, empty the bags and take them home again for reuse or disposal.

Hours are Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays 11 a.m.-7 p.m. Saturdays 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Sundays 11 a.m.-5 p.m. Closed Tuesdays, Thursdays and holidays.

Bags of leaves and grass may not be stored in your yard (It is a Health Code violation) The area behind the shelter is NOT for leaves or grass disposal.
